Value

Scope

Karlka Fencewright was contracted to supply and install 4,180 metres of Custom Garrison Security Fencing, and automated sliding gates at seven BHP mining camps near Newman, Western Australia.

We were also asked to support new landscaping. irrigation, and planting native flora. Artwork from a local Nyiyaparli artist was commissioned and transposed onto custom laser-cut aluminium sheets and installed on all fencing and gates.

Karlka Fencewright managed a workforce of over 60 people to complete the project, which also included demolition works and forming/pouring new concrete for footpaths and crossovers.

Challenges


The BHP Village Security Project presented a number of challenges to the Karlka Fencewright team. We were required to work around night shift rosters and engage with the public on all works being completed, which condensed the timeline for delivery.

Solutions

To meet the tight timelines and accelerate the process, Karlka Fencewright utilised its relationships with industry and quickly and efficiently onboarded new workers. We implemented management and supervision infrastructure to ensure teams were able to

Water Corporation - Two Rocks Borefields Project

Value

Scope

Karlka Fencewright was contracted to supply and install 202 metres of Garrison Security Fencing to three bore compounds in Two Rocks, Western Australia. All fencing had to meet strict specifications and was supported by anti-dig plinths, anti-ram security bollards, custom manual boom gates, and manual sliding gates.

All materials were custom fabricated in Karlka Fencewright's manufacturing facility and hot dip galvanized (in accordance with AS4680 and Water Corporation specifications), to ensure longevity.

Challenges

The location of this project presented significant challenges to the Karlka Fencewright team. We were unable to use traditional delivery methods to transport the materials and concrete trucks were unable to navigate the dirt roads to get to each bore pad.

Solutions

To address the terrain and location challenges, our installation team thought outside the box and utilised a specialised 4x4 truck to transport materials. This alternative vehicle was capable of traversing tough terrain and carrying a substantial amount of material to the bore sites, reducing the amount of trips needed. This helped to keep the project on time and on budget. Our team also used a skidsteer-mounted concrete hopper to ensure we could quickly and safely navigate the dirt roads and complete concrete pours.


